

COMPLAINT TO THE FIRST DEPARTMENT DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Due to the deceit, collusion and perjury by lawyers at Weil Gotshal & Manges (WG&M), I was unable to obtain a default judgment against "Citistreet", in my ERISA case in Brooklyn federal court against Citigroup, Inc., State Street Corp., Travelers, and others. (CV-02-6492). After the defendant Citistreet defaulted, WG&M by David Lender, Esq. falsely informed and swore to the court there was no legal entity called just "Citistreet".

As seen in the attached SEC 8-K filing by State Street Corp. dated December 8, 1999, (which I just now obtained) Citistreet is in truth, as my lawyer stated in court, and as WG&M kept denying, a 50/50 joint venture between Citigroup, Inc. and State Street Corp., with some \$200 billion in assets, millions of customers & 3,000 employees.

WG&M represented both State Street Corp. & Citigroup in my case. Unless the SEC filing by State Street was fraudulent, WG&M had to know that Citistreet was a 50/50 joint venture of its own clients, i.e. Citigroup & State Street. Even when confronted with clear evidence of the existence of Citistreet, WG&M refused to reverse their position.

The deceit of the denial by WG&M of the existence of Citistreet was a fraud that cost me dearly. It poisoned my case, which was then dismissed on the pleadings. The appeal was futile. WG&M kept on perjuring themselves, lying and deceiving the judges in each court about Citistreet's non existence. The Citistreet joint venture, though not licensed to sell insurance in N.Y., did so, and got commissions from Travelers, per federal 5500 filings.


In addition, WG&M swore that another defendant, Copeland Associates, Inc. which also defaulted, was a non existent entity, even after WG&M was shown over \$200k in checks that were written by Copeland Associates, Inc. years after they dissolved.

WG&M colluded with and suborned the perjury of a Mr. Robert C. Dughi. WG&M submitted to the court an affidavit from Mr. Dughi, who was then the president of Citistreet. Mr. Dughi denied the existence of his very own company. Mr. Dughi recanted at a January 5, 2005 hearing. On January 13, 2005 he retired. David Lender, Esq. also submitted his own affidavit about the non existence of Citistreet, but he never recanted.

I am attaching some documentation regarding the non existence of the Citistreet joint venture by WG&M. Citistreet maintains a website at Citistreetonline.com. It does not refer to itself as Citistreet LLC, as WG&M claimed it was. Citistreet coexists with Citistreet LLC and presents itself as Citistreet to the public on the World Wide Web. The court docket and some litigation papers are on the web at carminelopresti.com.

If Citistreet was non existent then why care about a judgment against an entity that does not exist? I suffered severe losses on account of the perjury by David Lender, Esq. and WG&M. Their fraud protected their clients: Citigroup, State Street Corp., Citistreet, & Travelers; deceived and defrauded the courts; and obstructed my ability to obtain justice.

The Departmental Disciplinary Committee has completed its investigation of your complaint against the above-referenced law firm. As explained below, the Committee has decided to take no further action.



The Committee arrived at this determination after the case was submitted to a member of the Committee, an independent board of lawyers and non-lawyers appointed by the Appellate Division, First Judicial Department. The Committee member concluded that no further investigation or action was warranted.


